

MCNY's Incorporating Purpose vs. Current Purpose

MCNY was envisioned as an education institution committed to the preservation and presentation of the history of New York. In fact, **the City of New York repurposed a “school site” to the Museum’s purpose**. It would be a travesty for City leaders to support any MCNY “purpose” at the expense of New York City residents’ and taxpayers’ ability to access MCNY’s unique collection for on terms spelled out in the 1928 Lease, as amended in 1931.
